**MARADE GUIDELINES**

The Marade officials will enforce strict adherence to the following guidelines by all Marade participants in order to ensure dignity, respect, and honor of Dr. King's memory.

1. Participants are asked to march with sacredness, refraining from offensive gestures and language, as well as aggressive behavior that is not respectful of Dr. King's memory.

2. No racial, sexual, cultural or other forms of bias will be permitted.

3. All interpretations of these guidelines will be made by MLK Marade officials.

4. Street-worthy floats will be allowed for a donation of \$1,000.00

5. **We require that you provide a one-course marshal for every ten participants.**
